New Delhi: July 1, 2024: Royal Enfield posted sales of **73,141** motorcycles in the month of June 2024 as against **77,109** motorcycles sold during the same month in the previous financial year. Royal Enfield exported **7,024** motorcycles during the month as compared to **9,614** during the same period last year.
