

ROYAL ENFIELD HITS ALL-TIME FESTIVE HIGH WITH 1,24,328 UNITS SOLD IN SEPTEMBER 2025

<u>Chennai: October 01, 2025:</u> Royal Enfield posted monthly sales of **1,24,328** motorcycles in September 2025 marking highest ever monthly sales figures in the history of the brand. The company witnessed **43%** growth over the same period last year against **86,978** motorcycles sold during the same month in the previous financial year. Royal Enfield exported **10,755** motorcycles during the month as compared to **7,653** during the same period last year.

Speaking about the performance for September 2025, **B. Govindarajan, Managing Director - Eicher Motors Ltd., and Chief Executive Officer - Royal Enfield,** said, "It has been an incredible start to the festive season for us at Royal Enfield, we have registered our best ever monthly sales volume and have crossed 1,00,000+ retail volumes for the month.
