THRILLING SHOWDOWN AT THE ROYAL ENFIELD CONTINENTAL GT CUP 2025 PRESENTED BY JK TYRE SEASON FINALE

- *Anish D Shetty dominated the professional category, and Bryan Nicholas led the amateur category, finishing with 77 and 87 points, respectively*
- *Anish D Shetty and Saran Kumar secured the Twin Power Trophy, jointly earning 117 points*

Coimbatore, November 17, 2025: The Royal Enfield Continental GT Cup 2025, presented by JK Tyre, wrapped up its fifth season in spectacular style at the Kari Motor Speedway, Coimbatore.

In an exciting showdown to the finish, Anish D Shetty claimed the title in the Professional Category, while Bryan Nicholas secured victory in the Amateur Category. In the Twin Power Trophy, Anish D Shetty and Saran Kumar triumphed together, highlighting the strength of teamwork and the bond between seasoned professionals and the rising stars.

Adding to the excitement, three-time MotoGP World Champion and Moto GP Hall of Famer Freddie Spencer graced the event, sharing invaluable insights from his illustrious career, inspiring emerging riders, and even taking the new motorcycle out for a spirited test ride.

With six months of fierce racing, from May to November 2025, the championship once again attracted entries from all across the country. With contestants battling it out on the racetrack, this edition of the GT Cup expanded on the successful Street to Track track format, nurturing the nation's finest racers, right from the grassroots. Across three rounds, the championship saw eight nail-biting races fueled by talented motorsport athletes from all over the country.

With nearly 6000 online registrations this year from across the country, over 500 aspirants were screened for zonals via eight zonal selections from which 64 made it to nationals from the zonals. The final 12 were shortlisted for the amateur grid while an additional 12 racers were shortlisted from 40 aspirants for the Pro grid, showcasing the highly competitive nature of the championship. The distinctive mentor-protégé relationship added an element of unpredictability right up to the finish line, highlighting exceptional skill and technique on the track.


