Nestled at 18,478 feet (5,632 M) above sea level, Mana Pass is a test of endurance and willpower - conditions only the most spirited riders dare to conquer. The Himalayan Mana Black Edition channels that bold energy through its distinctive design and ergonomics developed to optimise off-road riding. Draped in a deep Stealth Black finish with matte detailing, this edition embodies minimalism, purpose, and raw adventure, designed for those who see every trail as a calling, not a challenge.

The Mana Black edition captures the unyielding soul of its inspirational home: rugged, resilient, and unyielding. Equipped with factory-fitted, purpose-built kit, the Mana Black is designed for the spirited rider ready for extreme adventure. It is the ultimate expression of Royal Enfield's philosophy: the machine adapting to the Man, the Mindset, and the Mountain, empowering those who seek to go farther, explore deeper, and conquer in style.

A defining highlight of the Mana Black Edition is its **factory-accessorised configuration**. Riders can own a Himalayan that arrives fully fitted with exclusively curated adventure accessories. Equipped with **Black Rally hand guards**, a **Black Rally seat** for enhanced grip and long-distance comfort, a **Rally mudguard designed for rugged trails**, and **tubeless spoked wheels** that offer durability with modern convenience, the Mana Black Edition ensures every element is ready for exploration.

The motorcycle stays true to the refined performance and agility of the new Himalayan platform - powered by the Sherpa 450 engine, combining power with confidence to take on terrains from high-altitude passes to city commutes with equal ease.
